TRAINING VENUE CARPARK SAFETY POLICY

To make sure our members and volunteers stay as safe as possible while in the surrounds of our training venue Brothers Cricket Club on Golf Links, Drive Kirwan.

This policy aims to improve safety for members at Brothers Cricket Club

PROCEDURES:

1. Juniors waiting to be collected by parents are not to wait out the front, but around where there are still other people
2. At least two adults must remain until all juniors are collected
3. No one is to be left at the rooms on their own to lock up. There must be a minimum of two adults at all times remaining
4. Parents collecting children do so in a timely manner so that waiting around time for any person is kept to a minimum.
5. AFLTUA will provide a container in which members wallets, phones, keys or any other valuables should be stored for safe keeping until members have completed training.

AFLTUA WILL:

- Endeavour to make our training venue as safe as possible for members by putting in necessary steps to keep members safe.

MEMBERS WILL:

- Adhere to these steps for their own safety.
